Australian Sheep and Wool Show—Bendigo

Bindawarra fleeces have again won prizes at Bendigo. Steve entered a fleece that won the Champion Super Fine section with a score of 93/100. This score was only 0.25 less then the reserve champion of show. The fleece was 6.8kg (5.8kg clean fleece weight) with an outstanding yield of 85% and 63 newtons. This fleece was from a commercial ewe. This result exceeded all expectations. Megan's Henry has another ribbon for her, gaining second in the schools section. This will be Henry's last show fleece. Steve was also a steward for the Sheep Show, working for two days to showcase our Merino wool industry.
